



## Requirements for certified LiN-courses

To be able to conduct a certified course the following requirements must be fulfilled.

- A course room big enough for the participants and 1 bed per 3 participants
- Per bed:
  - 4 blankets
  - 2 pillows approximately 80 x 80 cm
  - 2 pillows approximately 80 x 40 cm
  - 2 small pillows (40x40)
  - 2 small and 1 big towel
  - Band-aid on rolls
  - Positioning material which usually is used in the facility but differs from the material listed above
- The 2<sup>nd</sup> day one wheelchair per 3 participants
- 1 chair for each participant / trainer / assistant
- Data projector / multi-outlet power strip / extension cord
- Flipchart or whiteboard with different coloured markers
- Nameplate for each participant / trainer / assistant
- A severely disabled patient per 3 participants on the ward. Patients should have low tone / no contractures in a basic course, high tone / contractures in an advanced course.  
He or his relatives should be informed about the course and should have agreed to his attendance. They also should be informed that photos of the positioning are taken—only for course, deleted directly afterwards.
- Ensure that the participants get the program at least one week before the course starts.
- Ensure that the hand-outs are printed and available before the course starts.
